MODULE 3 Part 5 - AI Transcript

The Planetary Consciousness of Mercury

And we're back with Part Five of Module Three. So, just to give a moment of recognition — this module is presenting a new level of code, new information. At any point, if you need to pause, please do so and honor your pace of receiving the beautiful Cosmic Design code. Honor that it is a lot of new information — it is very activating — so if you need to take a pause, please do so.

If you are willing and able to continue, then here we are at Part Five of Module Three.

Module Three is going to go into the conversation of **Mercury** and how the planetary consciousness of Mercury is matching, mirroring, and guiding the constellation of **Gemini**.

So, similar to **Sagittarius and Pluto** being connected through their energetic representation of the furthest-out point of our solar system — that threshold between the realms, and Sagittarius being the code that relates to the soul choosing to come into a human incarnation — Gemini and Mercury share a similar relationship, but Mercury is the *closest* planet to our solar system.

So that Stargate, where the soul enters through the Sun — again, metaphorically, energetically speaking — then comes into first contact with the planet of Mercury on the patterning of the solar system.

Pluto is the furthest out. Mercury is the closest. Sagittarius represents that initial seeking, the beginning journey of the soul. Gemini represents the first breath of coming into a human incarnation — that first breath of trusting the experience of being human.

And Mercury is connected to the Gemini constellation.

The Planetary Consciousness of Mercury



So let's dive into the planetary consciousness of Mercury.

The planetary consciousness of Mercury, similar to the codes of Gemini, revolves around *information*. The planetary consciousness of Mercury guides us into the codes of how we **give and receive information**.

While Gemini holds the codes of multidimensional wisdom — that very multifaceted relationship with information and communication — Mercury's planetary consciousness holds the codes of *how* we give and receive information.

So it is tied into this data. It is tied into communication.

Mercury's placement in a chart, or in a chart of the day, is going to provide insight into the *quality and capacity* that we have to give and receive information.

You can look at a Mercury placement and say:

“Okay, let's look and see where someone's Mercury is. Let's pull the core code of the constellation and weave it with this concept of giving and receiving information.”

That might identify how someone has the capacity to speak — or not speak. It might give insight into practices of opening that throat chakra energy, that communication energy.

It also might give insight into someone's capacity to communicate in different ways beyond just speech.

Communication Beyond Words

We give and receive information all of the time — it is not just when we are speaking.

While Gemini, the constellation, really focuses on the air energy and that communication via voice, Mercury brings into the code a more nuanced capacity of giving and receiving information on all levels.

We do this through our voice.

We do this through our facial expressions.

We do this through our body gestures.
We do this through our energy.

We give and receive information *all of the time*.

So Mercury is not just about vocal or voice communication — it is also the placement in the chart that is going to give insight and code around *how we communicate on all levels*, all of the levels of giving and receiving information.

Receiving Information

The *receiving* part of this is also important, because a Mercury placement can help identify, in a pragmatic way, *how we like to receive information*.

For example, in this training you have a video, you have audio, you have a full written transcript of the lectures, and you also have the AI summary.

These are four different avenues of receiving information.

Some people like to receive through their eyes — they like the visual cues of body energy, gestures, and facial expressions.

Some people like to listen — to hear, to process, to bring it into their body through their ears.

Some people don't want the visual or the audio — they prefer to read, to engage with the information on paper.

Some people prefer the summary — the high notes — and then go back into the details.

These are all examples of ways of processing information from different capacities, senses, and experiences.

So based on a Mercury placement in a chart, we can actually bring through the code of *how someone might learn, how someone might communicate, and how someone might move through difficult conversations*.

It is indicative of how we give and receive information — how we give it, and how we receive it.

It's a lot of beautiful code around how we communicate and how we want to be communicated with.

Collective Mercury: The Movement of Information

From a collective perspective — in the chart of a day — a Mercury placement might be indicative of how information is being shared in the greater collective.

If we look at the movement of Mercury, we can see how the movement of information is fast.

Mercury orbits the Sun most quickly — it is constantly moving through the constellations. It has the shortest orbit.

So it is a fast-moving inner planet, constantly stirring up different qualities of information.

When we fully grasp all of the codes of the constellations, we can see that on every given day there is a different code around how information is shared in the collective.

This helps us make sense of certain situations on the planet:
Why certain people are talking in certain ways, why some days communication feels different, why some days our technology feels rattled or obscured.

It is possible to correlate that with the movement of Mercury.

Mercury Retrograde

Now, I want to talk about **Mercury retrograde**, because it's a hot topic in traditional Western astrology — in our cultural pop astrology, people love to talk about Mercury in retrograde and how it's this big, problematic thing.

It gives a lot of excuses to a lot of people for why things are happening.

I like to, of course, read it from a different perspective.

First and foremost, I do *not* read retrogrades the way they have traditionally been read — through a negative lens. I like to flip it, elevate it, and bring it into an energetic that is more harmonizing, more optimizing, more elevated.

We'll go into the details of retrograde in a future module, but it's important to talk about Mercury retrograde now, as we're talking about Mercury as a planet.

Reframing Retrograde

Mercury retrograde is usually described as a time when technology breaks down or communication is difficult. There's some truth in that, because Mercury is the planet that brings information through the collective field.

But rather than blaming things on Mercury retrograde, let's use it as an *opportunity* to magnify and amplify our capacity for communication — our capacity for giving and receiving information.

When a planet is retrograde, it looks like it has stopped or started to move in reverse on the astrological wheel. It's simply an *amplified moment* of that planetary content.

So rather than blaming Mercury retrograde for what's not working, use it as a moment to hone in on your communication capacity — and communication beyond the voice.

How are you communicating with your body?

How are you communicating with your face?

How are you communicating with your energy?

How are you communicating with your clear senses?

Rather than using the cosmos as an excuse, use the cosmos as an *opportunity*.

When Mercury is in retrograde and everyone is fixated on it, you are invited — through the lens of Cosmic Design — to see it as an *opportunity* rather than a moment of panic or disillusionment.

Use it as a moment to ask yourself:

“How do I best communicate? How do I best receive information? What are the languages of nonverbal communication that resonate with me?”

Give yourself that portal of Mercury in retrograde to reflect upon how you give and receive information.

That simple shift is an example of how Cosmic Design *elevates* our relationship with planetary consciousness — rather than feeling stuck or stagnant within it.

In conclusion, Mercury is the planet of giving and receiving information.

It is one of the inner planets, moving more quickly around the Sun, and it is a planet we can track in the charts of the day to identify how information is moving through the collective — and how we are giving and receiving information within our own individual field.
