The Three Wheels of Cosmic Design

This lecture explores the **Astrological Wheel**, the **Wheel of the Year**, and the **Wheel as the Journey of the Soul**, revealing how each layer represents a deepening relationship with cosmic consciousness and the true design of the heavens.

1. The Astrological Wheel

The astrological wheel used in **True Sky Astrology** and **Cosmic Design** differs from the traditional Western zodiac. Rather than dividing the sky into twelve equal 30-degree segments, it honors the **true constellations**, each holding a unique number of degrees along the ecliptic. This circle of 360 degrees mirrors the view of the sky from Earth, mapping the real positions of the Sun, Moon, and planets.

Unlike the fixed symbolic zodiac, this system recognizes **13 constellations** along the ecliptic—Sagittarius, Capricorn, Aquarius, Pisces, Aries, Taurus, Gemini, Cancer, Leo, Virgo, Libra, Scorpius, and Ophiuchus—with **Orion** acknowledged as a 14th energetic constellation situated between Taurus and Gemini.

Students are encouraged to move away from the term *zodiac* and its archetypal associations. Instead, Cosmic Design works directly with the **stellar consciousness** of the constellations—the living light and frequency codes of the stars themselves. The astrological wheel thus becomes a **portal for communication with stellar intelligence**, not merely a symbolic map.

2. The Wheel of the Year

When viewed through a temporal lens, the same wheel represents the **Wheel of the Year**. Each degree of the 360-degree circle roughly corresponds to one day, allowing the Sun's annual passage to be traced around the wheel. Beginning with one's birthday, the daily motion of the Sun can be followed as it moves through each constellation.

Although there are 365 days in a calendar year, the astrological wheel provides an elegant, cyclical framework for tracking seasonal energy. This rhythm shifts slowly over time—about one degree every 75 years—as the constellations drift. Using this system, astrologers can pull a **chart of the day** to understand the energetic imprint of any moment.



3. The Wheel as the Journey of the Soul

Beyond mapping the heavens or the seasons, the wheel also reflects the **metaphysical journey of the soul**. This is an expansion beyond the four quadrants introduced earlier in the course, offering a full-circle view of incarnation and return.

- **Sagittarius** The soul's decision to incarnate; the seeker's call toward truth and experience.
- **Capricorn** Learning divine design; understanding the structure and purpose of being human.
- Aquarius Preparing for evolution and the collective work of the chosen lifetime.
- **Pisces** Signing soul contracts; preparing to enter physical form.
- **Aries** Conception; the ignition of spirit into the forming vessel.
- **Taurus** Gestation and embodiment; the soul grounding into physicality.
- **Orion** The energetic bridge between spirit and matter, marking entry into this dimension.
- **Gemini** The first breath of life; awakening to human consciousness.
- **Cancer** The emotional tides of early life and remembrance of spirit.
- **Leo** The joy, fire, and celebration of being human.
- **Virgo** The healing passage; the movement from healing to wholeness to holiness.
- **Libra** Harmony and balance; the exhale and integration of the incarnation.
- **Scorpio** Alchemy and transmutation; the beginning of return to spirit.
- **Ophiuchus** The gateway from physical back to metaphysical; rest and integration before rebirth.

Through this lens, the wheel becomes a **spiritual map** of both descent into and ascent from embodiment. Each constellation serves as a stage of remembrance, transformation, and return.

4. Integration

When all three perspectives are overlaid—the **astrological wheel**, **wheel of the year**, and **wheel of the soul**—the chart transforms from a static diagram into a **living portal of consciousness**. It becomes more than geometry; it becomes an entryway into cosmic remembrance, allowing the practitioner to commune with stellar codes, evolutionary cycles, and the timeless rhythm of the soul's unfolding.

Ultimately, this teaching reframes the birth chart as a sacred mirror of **cosmic design**—an alive, multidimensional tool through which we can observe light, time, and spirit weaving as one continuum.
