# MODULE 1 Summary

## *What Is True Sky Astrology and Why It Matters*

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### 1. Introduction

- Reintroduction to the concept of True Sky Astrology as an astronomically accurate system.
- Acknowledge that it feels new only because modern astrology drifted from its original relationship with astronomy.
- Emphasize: ancient humans always observed the actual sky—the Sun, Moon, and planets—as visible through direct observation and simple instruments.

### 2. The Historical Divide

- Over time, astrology separated from astronomy, creating differing systems.
- Key distinction:
  - Traditional Western Astrology → Symbolic, seasonal, based on a fixed 12-sign system.
  - True Sky Astrology → Astronomically accurate, based on constellations as they truly appear in the sky.
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- Mention Vedic Astrology as another ancient system that remains closely aligned with the actual placements of the planets.
- True Sky Astrology is most directly compared to Western astrology for the purposes of this training.

### 3. Traditional Western Astrology Overview

- Built upon 12 equal zodiac signs, each occupying 30 degrees of the 360° wheel.
- Originally correlated to the seasons—a symbolic way to track cycles.



- Strength: aligns humans with the natural rhythm of seasons.
- Limitation: disconnects from the real astronomical constellations, which differ in size and do not occupy equal degrees.

#### **4. The Size of Constellations & Astronomical Inaccuracy**

- Each constellation takes up a different portion of the ecliptic:
  - Pisces is large, Aries small, Taurus larger again, etc.
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- Because of this, the 12 equal slices of traditional astrology don't match the actual sky.
- Traditional Western astrology begins its year at 0° Aries (Spring Equinox), but astronomically, the Sun is in Pisces during the Equinox today.

#### **5. The Importance of Point of View**

- Seasonal experience differs between hemispheres:
  - Northern Hemisphere = Spring Equinox in Pisces
  - Southern Hemisphere = Autumn Equinox in Pisces
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- This highlights the importance of perspective—astrology mirrors how the individual relates to the greater whole.
- True Sky Astrology honors both hemispheres and situational viewpoints as reflections of divine diversity.

#### **6. The Concept of “True Codes”**

- “True Codes” are the energetic imprints of cosmic truth—direct transmissions from the cosmos, Earth, and the individual's unique perspective.
- The purpose of True Sky Astrology is to help individuals attune to these codes in alignment with the living sky.

#### **7. Why the Traditional System Drifted**



- Traditional astrologers rely on the Ephemeris, a planetary table calculated ~2,000 years ago.

## **8. The Precession of the Equinoxes**

- The Earth's axial tilt causes a slow wobble called precession, which shifts our point of view of the constellations.
- Every 75 years, the sky appears to move by approximately 1 degree.
- Over 2,000 years, that amounts to a 24-degree difference between the ancient tables and the actual visible sky.
- This means that many planetary placements in traditional charts are no longer accurate to the living sky.
- Some constellations are smaller than 24 degrees, which means an entire sign can shift—changing the constellation that the Sun, Moon, or planets actually occupy.

## **9. True Sky, Vedic, and Sidereal Astrology**

- Vedic Astrology (from ancient India) accounts for precession, keeping its calculations closer to the true positions of the constellations.
- Sidereal Astrology also adjusts for precession and aligns more accurately than Western astrology.
- However, some sidereal systems still divide the sky into equal 30-degree slices, while True Sky Astrology honors each constellation's actual size and overlap.
- This distinction makes True Sky the most living, relational, and astronomical form of astrology practiced today.

## **10. The Constellations as Puzzle Pieces**

- The constellations are not evenly spaced nor separated cleanly.
- They overlap and interlock, resembling puzzle pieces rather than tidy slices of a wheel.
- Some constellations even embrace portions of others, showing that cosmic design is fluid, not rigid.
- This divine architecture emphasizes interconnection—no sharp boundaries, only gradients of energy between the constellations.



## **11. Midpoints as a Method for Accuracy**

- To account for overlap and irregular size, True Sky Astrology uses midpoint calculation.
- The midpoint identifies the central energetic space between two constellations, defining where one ends and the next begins.
- Benefits of the midpoint system:
  - Respects the natural flow of the sky.
  - Honors the real dimensions of the constellations.
  - Removes the artificial 30-degree divisions.
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- All True Sky readings, including birth charts and transits, use midpoint dates for accurate placements.

## **12. The Ecliptic Plane**

- The ecliptic plane is the apparent path of the Sun, Moon, and planets across the sky as seen from Earth.
- It is the foundation of the astrological wheel—the circular diagram used for birth charts.
- Traditional astrology once placed the Earth at the center, assuming the cosmos revolved around it.
- With modern science, we now know Earth travels around the Sun, yet our viewpoint still originates from Earth's perspective.
- True Sky Astrology honors this balance: Earth as observer, Sun as center, and both as participants in a living cosmic rhythm.

## **13. The 13th Constellation: Ophiuchus**

- Along the ecliptic path lies the 13th constellation, Ophiuchus (pronounced oh-FEE-yuh-kus).

- It was removed from the zodiac during simplification efforts in Babylonian, Greek, and Roman times.
- Reintroducing Ophiuchus restores completeness to the zodiac, acknowledging the cosmic calendar as 13-fold rather than 12-fold.

- Its inclusion reconnects us to the true celestial story rather than the imposed pattern of 12 months.

#### **14. Calendars & Cultural Simplification**

- Around the same historical period, calendars were simplified—mirroring astrology’s reduction to 12 signs.
- The Babylonian, then Julian, and finally Gregorian calendars standardized months and seasons.
- Astrology became fused with this linear system, aligning human time with convenience rather than cosmic truth.
- The result: astrology and calendars became predictable but disconnected from the sky’s fluid reality.
- Returning to the cosmic calendar reconnects humanity with lunar and solar cycles—reawakening biological and spiritual alignment with nature’s timing.
