MODULE 3 Part 4 Bonus - AI Notes & Summary Midpoint Dates and the Wheel of the Year

In this short bonus lecture, the true-sky midpoint dates for **Gemini** are revealed: **June 18 through July 19**. This correction significantly shifts our seasonal understanding, as traditional astrology assigns much of this period to Cancer. Within Cosmic Design, Gemini and Cancer are distinctly different energies—complementary yet unique in essence.

Gemini holds the **anchor point of the Summer Solstice**, just as Sagittarius holds the **Winter Solstice**. Within Cosmic Design, they form an oppositional chord: Sagittarius as Truth and Seeking (December solstice) and Gemini as Trust and Experiencing (June solstice).
