The Astrological Wheel | Sagittarius & Gemini |

Truth & Trust | Pluto & Mercury

SECTION 1: The Living Wheel

Summary Concepts

- The astrological wheel in Cosmic Design represents *the soul's journey through consciousness*.
- Each constellation holds differing degrees of space, forming a spiral of experience rather than an equal circle of signs.
- The wheel mirrors both the **yearly cycle** (wheel of the year) and the **incarnational cycle** (wheel of the soul).
- The *midpoint data* marks the thresholds between constellations, creating energetic gateways.

Worksheet Prompts

1. Take out your chart and mark your sun placement with the day of your birth. Then count forward to your next placement and write the date of that placement.
 - Each dash mark represents about a day.
 - Continue if you can to mark the date of each placement in your chart.



SECTION 2: Sagittarius & Pluto Codes

Summary Concepts

- In Cosmic Design, Sagittarius aligns with **Pluto**, the planet of soul, choice, and school of the soul/lessons of each incarnation.
- Sagittarius is the *Seeker*, answering the soul's call to adventure — the one who walks toward truth, even when it disrupts comfort.
- Pluto initiates metamorphosis through soul choice and lived experience (collective and individual.)
- Together, they ignite the soul's first great quest: the courage to know truth beyond illusion.

Worksheet Prompts

1. Recall a moment in your life when you “answered the call.” What changed within you after that decision?
2. What truth is currently asking to be revealed in your life?
3. How do you relate to the energies of *death and rebirth* in your own transformation process?

SECTION 3: Gemini & Mercury Codes

Summary Concepts

- Gemini, opposite Sagittarius, represents **embodied trust** — the willingness to incarnate, to communicate, and to be human.
- Mercury governs Gemini as messenger, translator, and bridge between worlds.
- Gemini transforms duality into **multidimensionality**, where both/and consciousness replaces either/or thinking.

Worksheet Prompts

1. How does trust show up in your daily life? Where do you struggle to trust yourself or others?
2. What stories or beliefs keep you from feeling safe in your human experience?
3. Reflect on how you receive and translate divine information. How does your intuition communicate with you?

SECTION 4: The First Chord of Consciousness – Truth & Trust

Summary Concepts

- The First Chord of Consciousness is the sacred resonance struck when the soul chooses to incarnate and when the human chooses to stay.
- Sagittarius and Gemini create this chord: **Truth (Sagittarius)** and **Trust (Gemini)**.
- It is the pulse of the inhale and exhale, the seeker and the embodiment, the cosmic and the human.
- This chord asks: *Can I trust truth enough to live it?*

Worksheet Prompts

1. Write the statement: *I trust truth even when it asks me to change.*
 - How does that feel in your body?
2. What truth within you is asking for expression right now?
3. When do you feel the strongest harmony between your spiritual seeking and your human experience?

SECTION 5: Elemental Signatures

Summary Concepts

- The four elements — **Earth, Air, Fire, Water** — connect us to the living cosmos through the ancient lineage of land and spirit.
- In Cosmic Design, these elements are understood through their directional and energetic correspondences:
 - **North / Earth:** Grounding, structure, physical body
 - **East / Air:** Thought, perception, communication
 - **South / Fire:** Passion, vitality, movement
 - **West / Water:** Emotion, intuition, flow

Worksheet Prompts

1. Which element feels most natural to you right now? Which feels most imbalanced?
2. Write one daily practice that brings you into alignment with each element.
3. Reflect on how your elemental composition (as seen in your chart) influences your way of perceiving and creating.

REFLECTION QUESTIONS

Use these for journaling, meditation, or group dialogue.

1. What is your relationship to *truth* — as an idea, an experience, and an embodiment?
2. What is your relationship to *trust* — as a vibration, a practice, and a surrender?
3. How do you navigate the polarity of seeking/truth (Sagittarius) and receiving/trust (Gemini)?
4. What patterns have Pluto revealed in your life about soul choice, previous incarnations?
5. How does Mercury teach you about information, adaptability, and communication?
6. What elemental energy are you being invited to cultivate to stay balanced on your current soul wheel?
7. When do you feel most aligned with the living rhythm of the cosmos?
