## **MODULE 4 Part 4 - AI Transcript**

Welcome to Module 4, Part Four, where we will be discussing Venus.

Now, Venus is on the side of the solar system that we call the inner planets. So we just discussed that Neptune is a part of the wisdom planets, which are the far-out planets. Venus is a part of the inner planets. Now, we have been looping in this information, but I'll drop it in here now just to really clarify it.

The wisdom planets are much more of those generational planets. They take longer to move around the solar system. They are holding and anchoring those deep wisdom codes that deal with our generational information and more of our soul-coded information that comes from past lifetimes, infinite potential, multidimensional realities. So the wisdom aspect of the wisdom planets is just slower. It's older. There's more there.

The inner planets are the planets that hold the soul codes of our personality, of this lifetime, of how we are more specifically moving through this incarnation. So Mercury, Venus—we'll talk about Earth as a code—and Mars all hold those inner planet codes of how we are moving through this lifetime, which is different than the wisdom planets, which are much more the generational codes, the collective codes, and also more of our individual, deeper, more anchored incarnation cycle codes as they relate to our specific soul.

So just make note that the wisdom planets hold a certain quality, and the inner planets hold a certain quality. And so Venus is the second planet of the inner planets after we move from Mercury, which is closest to the Sun.

The orbit of Venus is 225 days, which is not even a full solar year. And as we talk about these orbits, it's also important to note that, based on the astrological wheel and our point of view from Earth, while the orbit of Venus is 225 days, it's not an exact count of the degrees on the wheel because we will have to take into consideration retrogrades.

Now, I haven't mentioned this before, and so I'm dropping it in now. Retrogrades are when we are looking at a planet and it appears to be either paused or moving backwards along the astrological wheel. So if we are looking at the astrological wheel, the Sun, the Moon, and the planets all move in that counterclockwise motion, moving through their orbit in that point of view from Earth—counterclockwise motion.

Now, when there is a retrograde, it appears that the planet has paused in the part of the sky where it is, or it's now moving clockwise along the astrological wheel. We will talk about this in depth in a future lecture, but for now, I just want to bring to the conversation that, while I am giving you the orbit of Venus and mentioned the orbit of Neptune being 165 years, the orbit of Venus being 225 days—it's not an exact count because of retrograde.

Venus as a planet has a rich history in the oral traditions and folklore of this planet. Often Venus is associated with beauty, with love, with the more sensual aspects of our human experience. And in Cosmic Design, we do lean into that code. We actually elevate it, though, to having Venus represent in the birth chart, the chart of the day, or a future chart, the information about how we give and receive love.

Now, Venus is connected to Cancer, and as we talk about in the Cancer lecture, Cancer has a fierceness to it. There is the fierce level of the mother. There is the fierce protection of the mother. There is the fierce and necessary nurturing that comes along with that divine flow, divine feminine—that true energy of the mother. And so Venus leans into this as yet another layer of that aspect of how we give and receive love.

Venus gives us the information in a birth chart not only of how we are going to give and receive love with other people, but primarily how we are going to give and receive love to ourself. So it is a very potent code to read through as it relates to self-love, which is the foundation of our movement here through this incarnation.

Without access to self-love and self-compassion, then we are very unlikely to be able to move through our healing journey or our other soul contracts that we've chosen for this life. So Venus becomes a super important placement to read in a birth chart so that we can start to decipher how one might give and receive love.

Mercury being the planet about giving and receiving information, Venus gives and receives love. We'll learn about Earth and Mars in future modules, but for now, what we can see is that these inner planets are very highly coded to be the information of how we are giving and receiving. So that can be elevated to: how are we interacting in this incarnation?

It very much has to do with our personality. It very much has to do with how we are moving through our day to day. So the inner planets hold that incarnation-specific, personality-specific, day-to-day interaction of how we're moving through this lifetime. The wisdom planets, again, are much more of that deeper soul code, generational information, collective information, and the anchor of the deep wisdom codes.

Now, as we read Venus being a part of the inner planets, being the code of how we give and receive love, it is a beautiful time to tune into how we express ourselves with our emotions. And the emotionality of humans is what makes us unique in the universe. I mean, on our planet that we know of as of yet, there is no other species that feels emotions at the same capacity that we do. And if we expand that into the solar system, there are no other species that we know of as yet that feel emotions the way that we do.

So emotions make us uniquely human. Part of reading the Venus placement is reading how we communicate our emotions, how we give and receive our emotions. Particularly, it is focused on love—that very core emotion of what makes us human—but also the ongoing relationship with our emotions.

So we can read Venus as the placement of love, of emotions, and also how we move through the enjoyment of life. And really, the enjoyment of life is created by our emotional experience. So as we navigate our emotions, as we give and receive our emotions, we can use our Venus placement to identify how to support our emotional navigation, how to inform our emotional navigation, and maybe even give us tools and tricks of how to more effectively move through our emotions with other people.

But the Venus placement always starts first with the individual. So—how are we emoting to ourselves? How are we giving and receiving love to ourselves? How are we tuning into self-compassion? And how does that deeper comprehension of our emotional experience move into the experience of this life?

It is a beautiful way to move through the layers and levels of this individual being and how we navigate this incarnation.
